## **ACD 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Scientific Meeting Adelaide, May 13<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> 2007**

The Canadian professors who pioneered the cosmetic use of Botox will be among some of the world's leading authorities on skin conditions and cosmetic procedures gathering in Adelaide next week for the Australasian College of Dermatologists' Annual Scientific Meeting.

Included in the program of speakers and events, will be a special presentation by the husband and wife team made famous for their discovery of Botox injections, Doctors Jean and Alastair Carruthers, who will demonstrate the latest cosmetic procedures, including the use of 'fillers'.

Another compelling delegate will be a Ugandan dermatology officer who will share his insights into the care of HIV AIDS patients in areas of northern Uganda, some of them very remote. Nicholas Etumoryee undertook his training in Tanzania with the support of the ACD.

Other presenters include the Visiting Professor for this year's meeting, Elise A. Olsen, MD, whose main focuses have been in hair disorders and cutaneous T-cell lymphoma.
