

INFORMATION FOR CONTRIBUTORS TO POSTER SESSION

Posters will be displayed throughout the Meeting, with a prize donated for the best poster.

Design of Posters

General:

Keep it simple! Keep it clear!
Inform and interest the viewer.
Use short titles and captions.

Size of Display:

1.8 m (long) x 1.2 m (high) per face of free standing unit.

Text and Graphics:

Indicate sequence clearly with numbers or arrows. Use prominent sub-headings.

Size of Lettering:

Titles and authors' names should be easily seen from a distance, e.g. 20 mm in height. This should head the poster. Text to be smaller but no less than 6 mm. Lines in graphics should be at least 2 mm thick.

Photographs:

Photographs need

1. Good contrast
2. Sharp focus
3. A scale to indicate size.
4. Clear caption set horizontally.

Transport and Mountings

Label components of the poster clearly in the middle back of each sheet.

Label the text and graphics so that re-assembly is easy. These latter two may be pre-mounted on back boards to fit a briefcase.

Thumb tacks, tapes or equivalent will be provided.
